Farmers Market Coupons

We are pleased to announce that NNORC will be distributing Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) coupons again this summer. The program helps low-income older adults aged 60+ access farm fresh local produce.

Each adult 60+ years in a household may receive a booklet if their household income does not exceed:

- \$2,413/month (for a one-person household)
- \$3,261/month (for a two-person household)

Participants will receive a list of where coupons can be used.

NNORC will be given booklets to distribute on a first-come, first-served basis. Please call our office at 518-516-1114 to reserve your booklet today. Each booklet must be signed for and given to each person directly. Booklets will be available around mid-July.

Cooling Assistance Benefit

The Cooling Assistance Benefit is accepting applications. If you are eligible, you may receive one Cooling Assistance Benefit per applicant household for the purchase and installation of an air conditioner or a fan to help your home stay cool.

Your household eligibility requirements include filing an application with your local department of social services, providing all necessary documentation, and the household must reside in an eligible living situation.
