A Word of Caution From Susan, RN


If you have high blood pressure be cautious about using NSAIDS such as Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin) and Naproxen (Aleve, Naprosyn) NSAIDS are among the most frequent offenders for raising blood pressure.

If you have pain from an injury or a chronic condition, consider non-drug remedies first, such as heating pads, ice, or physical therapy. Or, call and we can discuss relaxation techniques to help with pain management.


